I-20 AND M1 VISA INSTRUCTIONS

WHEN YOU RECEIVE YOUR I-20

- Go to www.fmjfee.com and pay the \$200.00 (I-901) SEVIS fee for your I-20.
- Keep your receipt to show proof of payment.

MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH YOUR LOCAL U.S. EMBASSY/CONSULTANT

- It is important to schedule an appointment far in advance.
- Visit <http://www.ustraveldocs.com> to find the nearest embassy and also to verify what documents you need to bring.

BRING TO U.S. EMBASSY INTERVIEW

- I-20
- I-901 fee receipt
- Financial statements
- Passport
- One 2X2 photograph
- Transcripts and diplomas from previous institutions attended

ENTERING THE UNITED STATES

- You will need to show the United States Customs Agent(s) your I-20, passport and M1 Visa.
- Your documents are extremely important, so keep them close to you at all times.

ATTENDING WESTWIND SCHOOL OF AERONAUTICS

- Stay in contact with Aftyn Beaird or Katie Nolen while attending Westwind School of Aeronautics.
- If for any reason you need to leave the United States, you must meet with the Student Services Department. If you fail to meet with the admissions staff, you may not be able to re-enter the United States.
- Be aware of your I-20 and I-94 expiration dates. It is student's responsibility to stay in compliance with SEVIS requirements.

CHECK YOUR VISA FOR ACCURACY

Once you receive your USA Visa from your embassy, you must check it for accuracy.



Please check all of these items and make sure they are correct!

- Your VISA must be an **MI VISA** you can check this by looking at the Visa Type/Class section of your VISA. Circled and arrowed above.
- Check to make sure your Surname and Given Name(s) are spelled correctly.
- Check to make sure your passport number is correct.
- Check to make sure your Gender (M or F) is correct.
- Check to make sure your Nationality is correct.
- Check to make sure your Birth Date is correct.
- Check to make sure **WESTWIND SCHOOL OF AERONAUTICS** is shown in the Annotation section of your VISA.
- Look for any incorrect information on your VISA. Failure to catch any errors could result in denial of admittance into the United States Port of Entry. You would then need to return to your home country to get the error corrected at the embassy. This would be at your expense.
- If any errors are found on your VISA, please get them corrected immediately at the issuing embassy. If you have any questions concerning your VISA, please contact Westwind School of Aeronautics:
