

Over 15 weeks, trainees will receive 30 x 1 hour lessons of expert tutoring, to complement approximately 8 hours of self study each day. There is then a 3 week exam preparation course at Capt Sahil Khurana Aviation Academy (CSKAA), Sector-7, New Delhi, taken before the final course exams

COURSE OVERVIEW

How is the programme structured?

Training is predominantly completed through supported self-study, using Padpilot CBT. Regular progress tests are taken via SKYWORX. There is also a 3 week exam preparation course taken at Capt. Sahil Khurana Aviation Academy (CSKAA) in New Delhi before the final course exams.

All subjects are studied in parallel and include AGK, Met, PoF, M&B, IN, Nav Gen, AL, Performance, FP, HP, RN, OP and CM.

How long does the programme take to complete?

The course is completed typically in 18 weeks. This consist of 15 weeks of distance based learning (48 hours study per week) and 3 weeks of exam preparation course in New Delhi.

What are the pre-entry requirements?

Before starting the SKYWORX DGCA Distance Learning course you must:

- Be 17 years of age at time of course commencement
- Hold a valid DGCA Class 2 Medical Certificate
- Education: 10+2 with English, Math & Physics or A higher degree in those subjects
- Must be fluent in English both written and spoken

 Be an Indian national or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) holder.

If applying onwards to airline programmes, academic minimums may vary?


What is the cost for the programme?

The cost for the programme is \$3,000 plus GST. This does not include

- Exams fees (INR2500 each)
- Equipment MAC or iPad required for training programme
- Jeppesen manual
- Travel and accommodation for the 3 weeks exam preparation course at Capt Sahil Khurana Aviation Academy (CSKAA) in New Delhi
